2021 Project Updates

Denville Project: On August 15, 2020 ACT Now! served a family who was in need of alterations for a family member who lost both legs due to COVID-19 complications. We worked on creating an accessible route to the front door by extending a concrete walkway, eliminating the need to navigate a small set of stairs. We also trimmed shrubs that had overgrown reducing the width of the front walk. We repaired cracks in the walk, installed new aluminum ramps at the front and back doors, and built a wood ramp to provide access to the family's deck. **ALL IN ONE DAY!**



Chester Project: Pastor Layne from **1st Congregational Church of Chester** identified a family that needed renovation to a bathroom. ACT Now! could not physically do the work but we were able to make a financial contribution to have professionals perform the needed repairs.

Morristown Project: The Benevolence Team from **Hope Church** was approached by a family in need of repairs to their front porch. After reviewing the project it was determined to be a bit outside of the capabilities of ACT Now! But, we were able to partner with Hope's **"B-Team"** to make a financial contribution to **Morris Habitat for Humanity** to help pay for the needed materials.
